Three Dodgers 1'S Pitchers Combine In Shutout Victory Against Scots

Dodgers 1's defeated Scots 26-0 on Sunday as three pitchers combined to throw a shutout. Tyson Cox struck out Berin Murchison to finish off the game.

Dodgers 1's fired up the offense in the first inning. Cox singled on a 1-0 count, scoring two runs.

Dodgers 1's scored eight runs in the third inning. Dodgers 1's 's big bats in the inning were led by singles by Anthony Amsing, Jack Warner, and Rod Baulch, by Aaron Petri, a fielder's choice by Brett Ritchie, and a double by Amsing.

McDonald went 2-for-2 at the plate to lead Scots in hits.
